Frontrunners

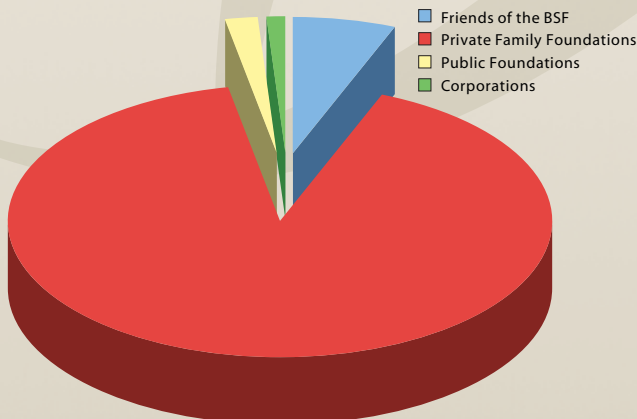

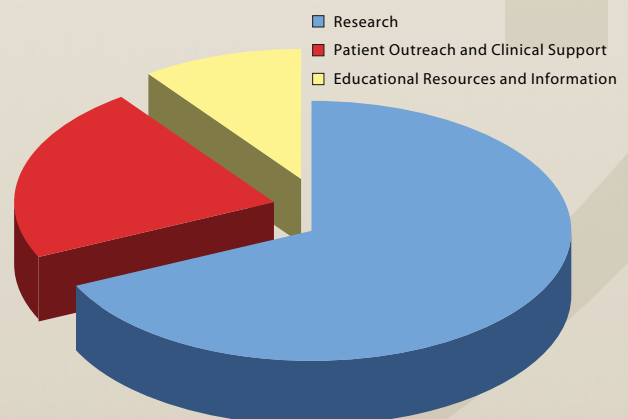
